

IN THE SYLLABUS OF TRAINING, SUBJECTS ARE GROUPED INTO VARIOUS GROUPS. EVERY PROBATIONER IS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN IN EACH GROUP OF SUBJECTS A MINIMUM PRESCRIBED MARKS, AS PER RULES, IN THE WRITTEN AND PRACTICAL EXAMINATIONS, TOURS AND EXERCISES. FOR QUALIFYING EXAMINATIONS MINIMUM STANDARD IS SPECIFIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE ACADEMY. IN CASE A PROBATIONER FAILS IN A SUBJECT IN HIS/HER FIRST ATTEMPT THEN ONLY ONE MORE CHANCE IS GIVEN FOR PASSING THE SAME. IN CASE OF SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES TWO TYPES OF DIPLOMAS ARE AWARDED DEPENDING ON THE PERFORMANCE. IN CASE MARKS SCORED ARE FROM 50% TO 74.99% THEN PASS DIPLOMA IS AWARDED AND FOR THOSE PROBATIONERS WHO SCORE MORE THAN 75% MARKS, HONOURS DIPLOMA IS AWARDED. 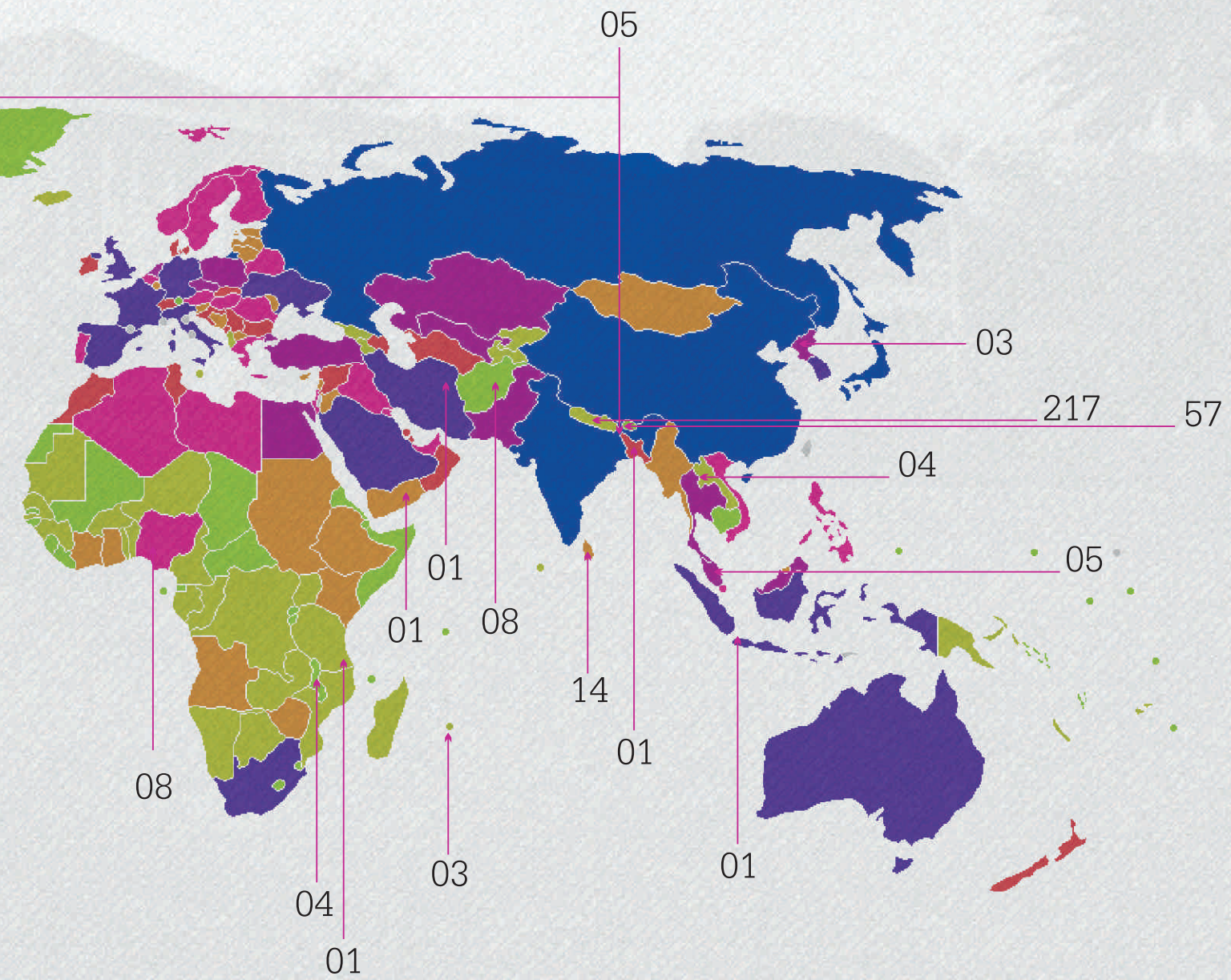
